#### 2. General

The TLP175A photorelay consists of a photo MOSFET optically coupled to an infrared LED. It is housed in a 4-pin SO6 package. This photorelay requires 1mA of LED current to turn it on. It is suitable for applications that need electrical power savings.

#### 3. Features

- (1) Normally opened (1-Form-A)
- (2) OFF-state output terminal voltage: 60 V (min)
- (3) Trigger LED current: 1 mA (max)
- (4) ON-state current: 100 mA (max)
- (5) ON-state resistance:  $50 \Omega$  (max)
- (6) Isolation voltage: 3750 Vrms (min)








Fig. 12.1 Switching Time Test Circuit and Waveform




Fig. 13.1.1 I<sub>F</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>




Fig. 13.1.2 I<sub>ON</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>




Fig. 13.1.3 I<sub>F</sub> - V<sub>F</sub>




Fig. 13.1.4 I<sub>ON</sub> - V<sub>ON</sub>




Fig. 13.1.5 R<sub>ON</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>




Fig. 13.1.6 I<sub>FT</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>






Fig. 13.1.7 t<sub>ON</sub>, t<sub>OFF</sub> - I<sub>F</sub>




Fig. 13.1.8 t<sub>ON</sub>, t<sub>OFF</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>




Fig. 13.1.9 I<sub>OFF</sub> - V<sub>OFF</sub>





Fig. 13.1.10 I<sub>OFF</sub> - T<sub>a</sub>
