

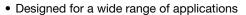

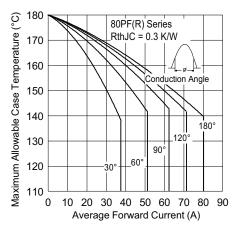


Fig. 1 - Current Ratings Characteristics

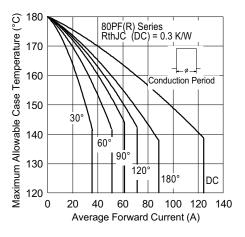


Fig. 2 - Current Ratings Characteristics

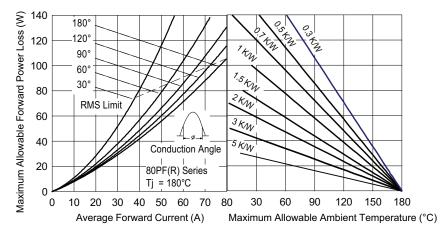


Fig. 3 - Forward Power Loss Characteristics

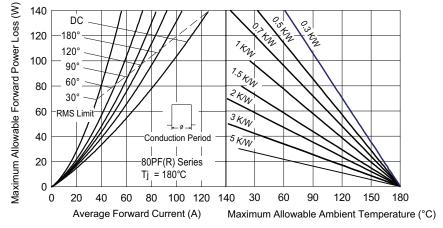
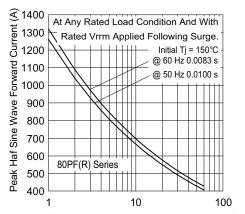


Fig. 4 - Forward Power Loss Characteristics

Fig. 5 - Maximum Non-Repetitive Surge Current

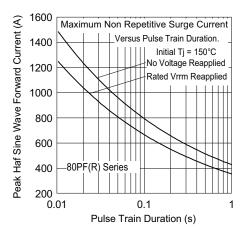


Fig. 6 - Maximum Non-Repetitive Surge Current

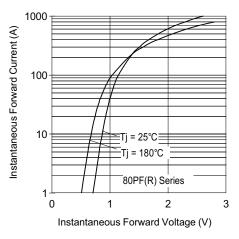


Fig. 7 - Forward Voltage Drop Characteristics

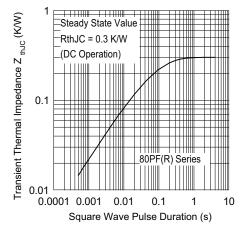
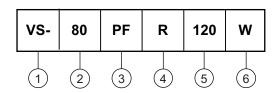


Fig. 8 - Thermal Impedance Z_{thJC} Characteristics

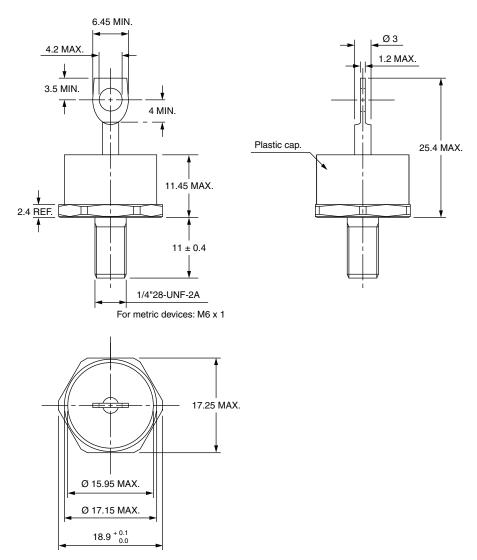

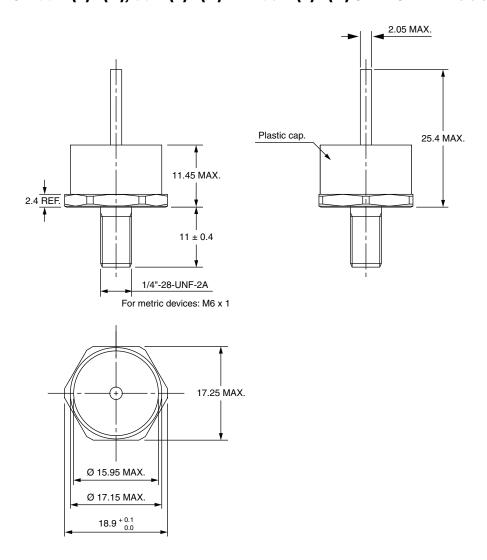
DIMENSIONS FOR 80PF(R), 50PF(R) AND 95PF(R) SERIES in millimeters

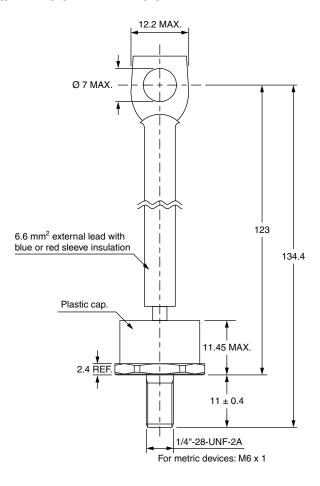
DIMENSIONS FOR 80PF(R)...(W), 50PF(R)...(W) AND 95PF(R)...(W) SERIES in millimeters
